This manual is a very convenient hand book for those learning and practising fine needle aspiration cytology. Almost all organs of the body have been dealt with. Diagnostic cytological criteria of different lesions are given pointwise and at many places in tabular form making it easy for the pathologist to remember differential diagnosis. Added features is good number of coloured microphotographs making the book an atlas. All the pages are of art paper giving the manual a nice get up. This manual will be a helpful guide to all postgraduates and those practising FNAC and should be possessed by all pathology departments and libraries.
